

BASIC FOUNDATION PAPER PIECING JARS AND BASKETS

In this class you will make a wall hanging from 3 or more paper pieced blocks of jars or baskets. You will learn different methods of paper piecing. You may choose your layout. Also there will be some more difficult blocks to piece that may be used for potholders or to start another quilt.

The supply list is for the wall hanging. I will have fruit and vegetable fabrics as well as other miscellaneous foods. If you have something you want in the jar or basket bring it.

SUPPLY LIST:

Sewing machine in good working order

Paper scissors and fabric scissors

Thread

Rotary cutter

Small cutting mat (if you have one)

Small iron and pad (if you have one)

Ruler with good quarter inch line

Seam ripper

Spray water bottle

FABRIC:

$\frac{1}{2}$ yard light fabric for background

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard for shelves and first border

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard for last border

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard for binding

Miscellaneous fabrics for in jars or basket

Fat quarter basket type fabric

$\frac{1}{2}$ yard batting and backing fabrics

Fat quarter of light and fat quarter med
to dark

Goal is to become comfortable with paper piecing. It has it's place in quilting more accurate blocks.
