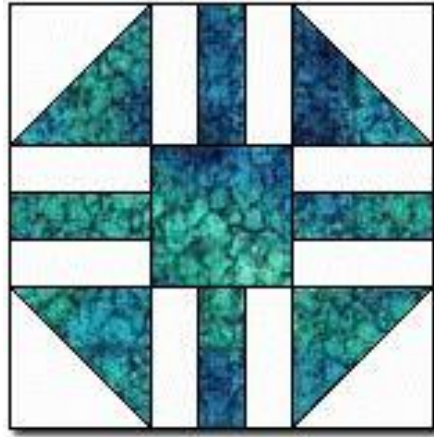


# Laura's Quilt Slushy Community Sewing Block

## Paths and Stiles

Batiks that read like a solid and white on white



9.5" unfinished

Make two, one to donate to Community Sewing and one for the drawing.

Cutting instructions:

Batik and White on White:

2 3 7/8" squares – draw a diagonal line on the white squares

White on White:

2 1 1/2 x 14" strip

Batik:

1 3 1/2" square

2 1 1/2 x 14" strips

Sewing Instructions:

With a white and batik square, right sides together, sew just scant of a 1/4" seam on either side of the drawn line. Cut on the line and press to the dark. You should have four 3 1/2" half square triangles. Please square up if possible.

Sew a white on white strip to either side of the batik strip, sewing along the long edge. Press to the dark and cut into 3 1/2" squares.

Refer to the picture above and piece the block.
