### Supply List

**General Supplies** – Sewing machine in good working order

Rotary cutting supplies

Coordinating threads for your project

Miscellaneous: sharp scissors, pins, needles ...

### **Magic Tile Block Construction** - Gayle Hazen \$10

The Magic Tile block has the look of stained glass. It lends itself well to a theme or collection (Christmas, flowers, etc.) or a color scheme. We will be making 12 blocks that you can set any way you'd like at a future date.

12 PRE-CUT 12-1/2" squares in a collection of your choice

18 PRE-CUT 1" x WOF (42") strips for "grout". Lighter or darker than your squares, a solid works well.

Ruler (at least 18") and pencil

Rotary cutter and mat

I will provide paper for your cutting pattern

### **Playing Card Holder** - Sharon Weekly \$0 – see \*\*Note below

Scissors and Sewing Machine, marking tool, pins... Paper and pen for notes.

Heavy thread such as topstitch, button or upholstery thread

Hand sewing needle with eye big enough to accommodate heavy thread

\*2 pieces quilting cotton 8" x 8"

\*2 pieces cotton batting 8" x 8"

\*2 buttons approximately 7/8"

\*2 CDs

\*\*Note: Buttons, batting and CD provided for your bazaar donation. If you would like to make one for yourself, please bring your own fabric, batting and buttons. We'll still provide the CD.

## **Open Up Box Pouch - Sharon Weekly \$15**

1. Assorted fabric scraps to cover a 9" w X 13" h rectangle. I have used random blocks and scraps from a newly completed quilt.

••• NOTE I will have zippers on a roll available to use. If you would like to use please keep these colors in mind when choosing your fabrics•••

Black with gold teeth

Gray with silver teeth

White with rose gold teeth

If you would like to bring your own zipper it needs to be at least 15" nylon. These zippers are available at Northern Threads

2. Quilting cotton 10" X 10" side panel

3. Fat quarter for lining

4. Your favorite marking tool. To mark quilt lines. I used a Frixion pen

5. Sewing machine, scissors and thread to match your project.

6. Please use a new sewing machine needle. 90/14 it is much easier to sew through multiple layers of foam with a strong new needle. I recommend Organ, these are available at Northern Threads.

## **Notan (or The Expanded Square) - Gayle Hazen \$15**

Design a unique art quilt using this Japanese design principle of light & dark. I will present the steps to creating your Expanded Square and demo how I use a quick reverse appliqué technique to sew it up. We will practice on some designs I've previously prepared, but you'll learn the skills needed to produce more on your own.

Neutral colored thread, pencil, scissors

Darning foot, or foot for free-motion quilting if you have one.

-One Fat Quarter in a solid color

-Two Fat Quarters with high contrast to your background fabric (can also be solid)

-Glue Stick

-Neutral colored thread, pencil, scissors

-X-Acto Knife (#11 blade) or small sharp scissors. Bring small cutting mat if using an X-Acto knife.

I will provide the black & white papers for the design process & tracing paper for when we sew.

## **Block Design Board - Sue Gross \$5**

Make a small, easily portable design board

1 foam core board (available at Office Max)

3 - 3" wide WOF strips of fabric for binding

Glue gun, if you have one.

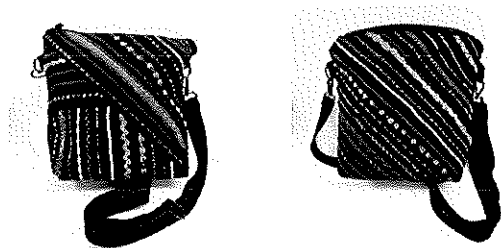
Batting will be supplied

## **Design & Make Your Own Bag - Corlis Taylor \$20 plus \$5 materials fee**

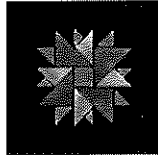
**Description:** Design your own purse, crossbody bag or tote perfectly sized for you. This will be a one-of-a-kind bag that you will make by first making your own pattern based on the size and shape you want. Our sewing machines have so many decorative stitches that we will use with threads, yarns, and trims to create the outside of our bag. Decide on your lining, how many inside pockets and how your bag will close – with a snap or zipper. This will be a versatile go to bag for any use and you made it.

### **Materials List:**

- Sewing machine with zig-zag foot, additional optional feet, open toe foot, clear foot
- Machine needles size #80 also topstitching needle size #90
- 1-yard solid black fabric
- 1 -yard Fabric for lining
- Chalk marker
- Variety of colors of threads, trims, and yarn (if you have some)
- Zipper for bag closure or a bag snap
- If you are making a cross body bag you will need hardware: 2 d rings, 2 clips, 1 slide



**Quilt Block Clock - Sarah Shawcroft \$38**



Price includes pattern, 2 pieces of plexi glass and the clock works.

13" fusible fleece

13" background fabric

Numbers for clock face (If needed)

Matching thread for quilting

Color 1 (purple): One 5-1/8" x 10-1/4" strip

Color 2 (orange): One 3-7/8" x 7-3/4" strip

Color 3 (teal): One 2-3/8" x 4-3/4" strip AND one 3" x 6" strip AND one 2-5/8" square

Color 4 (black): One 2-3/8" x 4-3/4" AND one 3" x 18" strip AND one 5-3/8" x 10-3/4" strip

**Accuquilt dies - Mary Olson \$10**

I will have a large variety of seasonal dies and several cutters available for use. There are snowflakes, reindeer, leaves, pumpkins, gingerbread people, a cat, a bat, a sleigh, penguin, gnome, trees, moose... Embellish table runners, placemats, mug rugs, clothing, bags....

Cotton Fabric – Various sized scraps. Minimum size aprox. 2".

Wonder-Under – double sided fusible
