

# August Block of the Month

## Cutting Corners from the Missouri Star

Holiday Vol 3 issue 4

White, blue, yellow (some green okay)

6.5" unfinished

Cutting instructions:

White:

1 10" square

Assorted blues/yellows:

5 2.5 x 10.5 strips

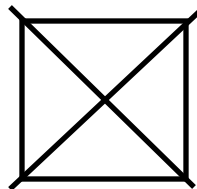


Construction:

Sew strips together as shown above. If you alternate ends when you start sewing, it will keep the finished strips flat. Press seams all in the same direction. When finished, trim to a 10" square. When trimming I made the top and bottom strips 2".

With right sides together, place white 10" square on top of strip set. Sew a 1/4" seam on all sides. Sew all the way to the end and turn, instead of pivoting at the corner. This will make a nice crisp corner.

After pressing cut corner to corner.



Open and press to the white and trim dog ears.

Abacadabra you will have four 6.5" blocks!!!

(the fabrics are not the same as in the strip set above)
