11" unfinished

White on white / white on black

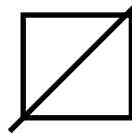
Bright colors that read like a solid



Cutting Instructions:

White on white

- 1 2 1/4" x 23 inch strip
- 2 4 1/2 inch squares—draw a diagonal line on each



White on black

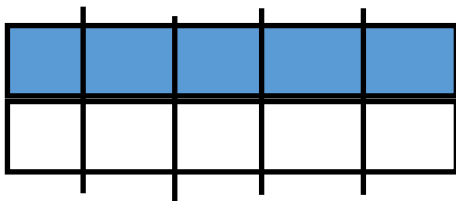
- 2 4 1/2 inch squares
- Bright fabric that reads like a solid

- 1 2 1/4" x 23 inch strip

Sewing Instructions:

Place white fabric squares on black squares. Sew a scant 1/4" seam on either side of line. Cut on drawn line, press to the dark and trim to a 4" square

Place white fabric strip on colored fabric strip, and sew a 1/4" seam. Press to the dark and cut sewn strip in half. Lay one sewn strip on top of the other with opposite colors on top of each other, nesting the seams. Cut 2 1/4" strips through both layers. Sew a 1/4" seam on each, press and there are your four patches.



Referring to picture 1, layout pieces of block.

Sew together in rows and follow pressing arrows on picture 2.

Sew rows together to complete block.
