Keys to Freedom

Quilter's World June 2011

Cutting Instructions:

Red:	4	3" squares	Blue:	2	3" squares
Neutral:	6	3" squares		2	3.5" squares
	2	3.5" squares—draw diagonal line			

Sewing Instructions:

1. Place neutral 3.5" squares on top of blue 3.5" squares right sides together. Stitch on either side of the drawn diagonal line.

Cut on drawn line, press to the dark and trim to 3" half square triangles.

2. Refer to picture and sew 2 half square triangles to the blue squares and 2 half square triangles to a white square. This will create four units.

Press to the solid square and then sew these units into a four patch.

3. Sew red and white squares together to form four units. Sew these units together to form two four patches.

4. Using the picture above, sew the four patches together, to create the

Keys to Freedom block.



I pressed this block to the dark or solid squares as I was sewing. When I sewed all the four patches together I had to press some partial seams the opposite way. It's a bit clunky, but the seams nestled together.
