Wizard's Chess

McCall's Quick Quilt's June/July 2017

9 1/2" unfinished



Cutting:

White

- 1 4" square—cut diagonally C
- 1 2" x 8 1/4" strip

Black on White

- 1 2" square A
- 1 2 x 3 1/2" rectangle D
- 1 2 x 5" rectangle E
- 1 2 x 6 1/2" rectangle F

Black

- 2 2 3/8" square cut diagonally B
- 1 2" x 8 1/4" strip
- 2 2" squares A

Brights—aqua, purple, turquoise, magenta, see example above.

- 1 2" square A
- 1 2 x 3 1/2" square D
- 1 2 x 5" rectangle E
- 1 2 x 6 1/2" rectangle F

I found it helpful to lay the pieces out just like the diagram below. This block looks complicated, but it really went together quickly.

Join the white and black 2" strips right sides together and sew a 1/4" seam on the long side. Press to the black and cut into four 2" units. Labeled Unit 1 in the diagram to the right.

Referring to the diagram to the right sew the pieces together. Press to the black.

You may have to trim the B triangles after sewing to E and F, before adding the white C triangle.
