Fall colors and prints

Block is 12.5" unfinished



Cutting instructions:

From each of two coordinating fall print or colored fabrics that have a contrast:

Cut one 2.5" WOF (width of fabric) strip

Sewing instructions:

I'm not sure if it is necessary in the construction of this block, but I have written the instructions to minimize the curving of strips sewn together.

With right sides together, lightest fabric on top, sew a **1/4" seam** - mark the end you started from with a pin or a pencil mark.

Press to the darkest fabric. Square up one end of the strip and measure the length. You will be cutting three equal sections. If the strip is 40.5" long, you can cut the sections 13.5" each. If it is shorter you can adjust the length, but you need 39" minimum. As you cut the sections, mark the end that is the starting end of the original seam.

Sew the strips together with a marked end on top of an unmarked end.

Press all the seams in the same direction. Carefully square up one end, remember you need this unit to be 13" long. From this unit make a cut at 3.5" and the remaining piece should measure 9.5"

Rotate the 3.5" inch piece and sew to larger 9.5" piece.
