

October—BOM—Log Cabin

This block is made with a cranberry/burgundy center and off white/cream and blue logs

The inside logs should read medium blue with the outside row a darker shade of blue.

This block can be made as scrappy as you like.

The block should measure 11”.

Cutting instructions:

Burgundy/cranberry

1 2” x 2” square

Cream/off white

1 2” x 2” square

1 2” x 3.5” rectangle

1 2” x 5” rectangle

1 2” x 6.5” rectangle

1 2” x 8” rectangle

1 2” x 9.5” rectangle

Medium Blue

1 2” x 3.5” rectangle

1 2” x 5” rectangle

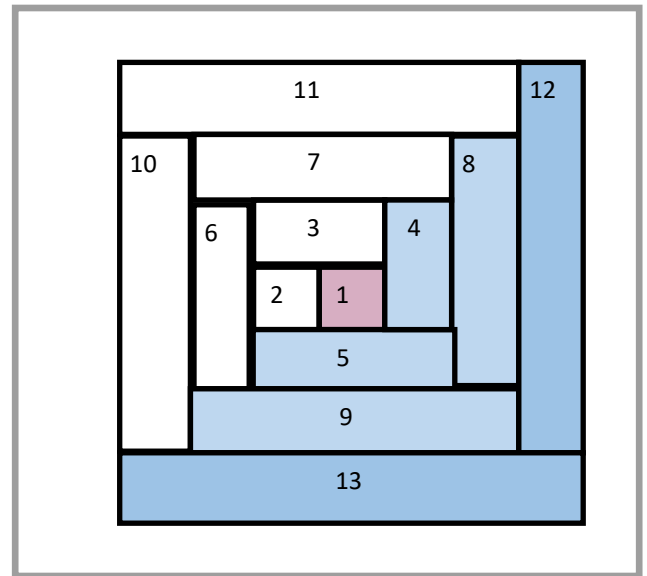
1 2” x 6.5” rectangle

1 2” x 8” rectangle

Dark Blue

1 2” x 9.5” rectangle

1 2” x 11” rectangle



Sewing instructions:

Follow the diagram next to the cutting instructions. I found it helpful to lay all the pieces out in the right order. This block needs a consistent 1/4” seam. Please take the time to square up your block as you add rows.
