Louisiana—*Around the Block with Judy Hopkins* page 83

I have blueberries on my mind, so this pinwheel block features blueberry fabric pinwheels with an off white/cream background and one coordinating fabric.

This block should measure 8 1/2" when you are finished

I have included two instructions for creating flying geese.

Cutting instructions:

Background fabric—off white/cream
4 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle

Flying Geese:

Blueberry fabric
4 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
Coordinating fabric
8 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares

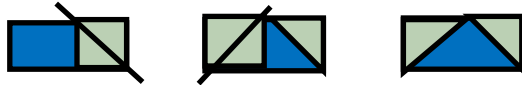
OR

No Waste Flying Geese:

Blueberry fabric
1 5 1/4" square
Coordinating fabric
4 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" squares

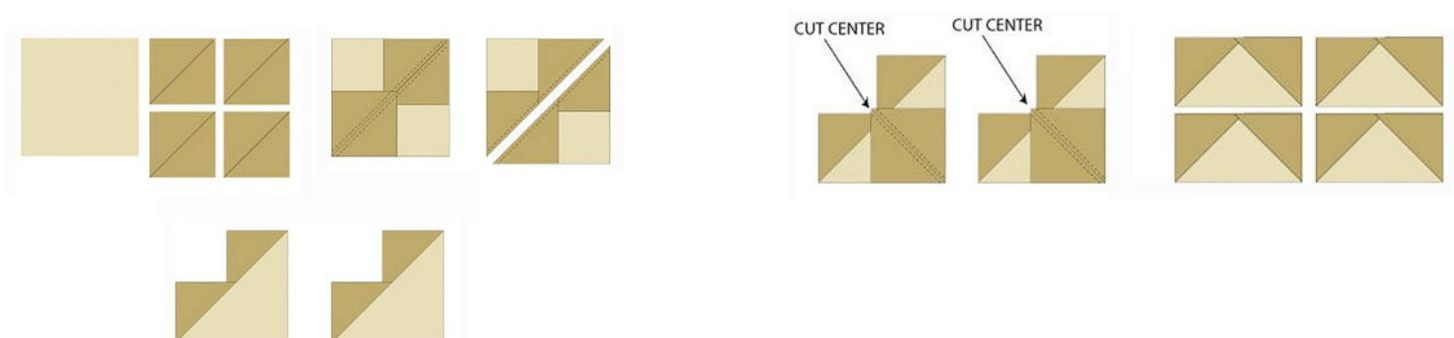
Sewing instructions:

Flying Geese—draw diagonal lines on the wrong side of the 8 2 1/2" squares. With right sides together sew as shown in diagrams.

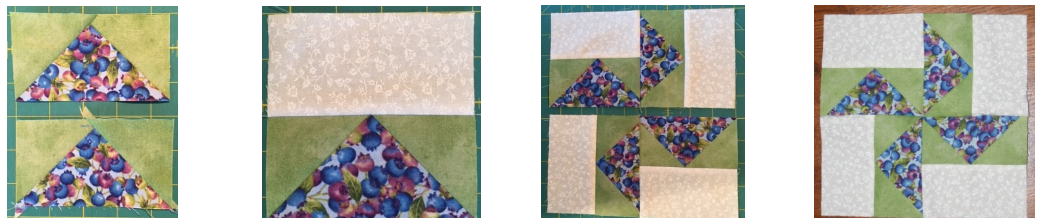

Trim Flying Geese to 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" which will also trim off dog ears.
