
Christmas Trees - Paper Pieced (with optional flying geese directions)


8 1/2" X 8 1/2" Unfinished

Scraps of red, green, white/cream fabric. Refer to drawings below for color placement; blocks with red side borders will have green trees, blocks with green side borders will have red trees. Both blocks will have the white/cream behind the trees. If using the optional method, your trees will all be the same fabric. Unless you make more than one set!

Make copy(s) of the paper piece pattern for trees. Paper piece using green or red for trees. Trim – cut on dotted lines. Remove paper. Add sides of 2 ¾" x 8 ½" rectangles. Press. Square to 8 ½" x 8 ½'.

Optional: Instead of

Paper piecing, make

4 flying geese using:

1 – 5 ¼" square green or red

4 – 2 7/8" squares of white/cream

Finished size of flying

Add sides of $2 \frac{3}{4}$ " x $8 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

Square to 8 ½" x 8 ½"
