The June ending balance is 17,385.15. The regular account has \$14,906.81 after \$586.26 in expenses and \$542.00 in deposits. QOV donated \$500 towards quilting. The raffle account has \$3,063.11 after expenses of \$59.97 and raffle deposits of 689.00. The combined total is \$17,969.92.
