BLOCK OF THE MONTH

January 2019 Block of the Month

White or cream Cut (2) 5" squares

Blue Cut (2) 5" squares

Place one white and one blue right sides together

Draw a diagonal line (A)

Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the line (B)

Repeat for the other two squares

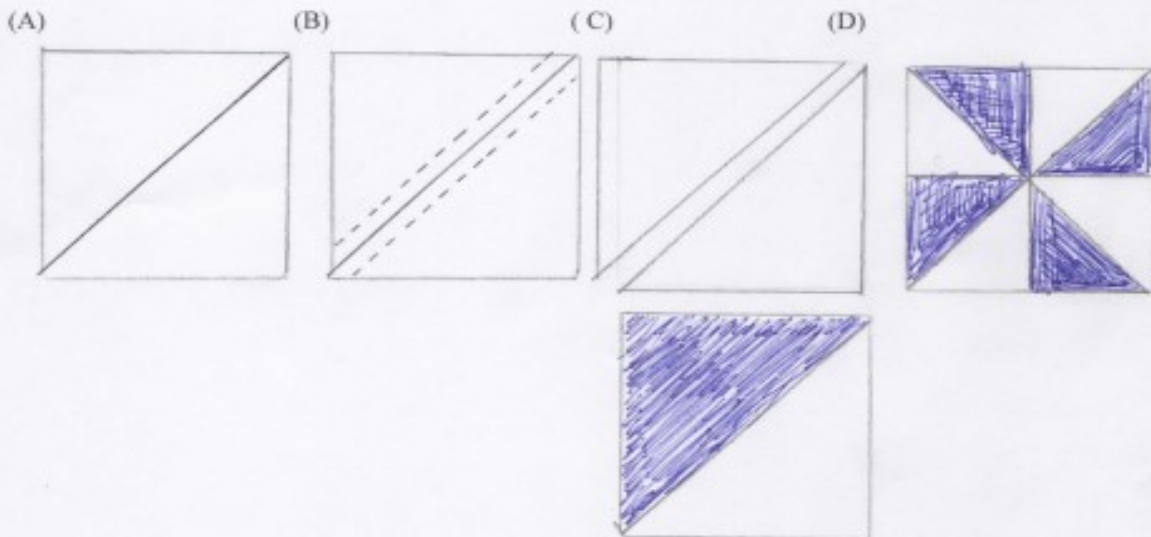
Cut on the diagonal lines giving you (4) half square triangles (C)

Press toward the blue

Sew together to make a pinwheel block (D)

DO NOT TRIM THE BLOCKS!!!

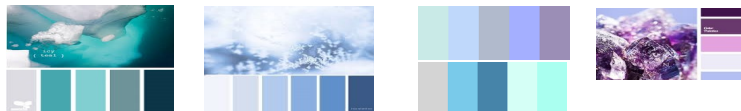
The winner of the blocks will trim them!!!
