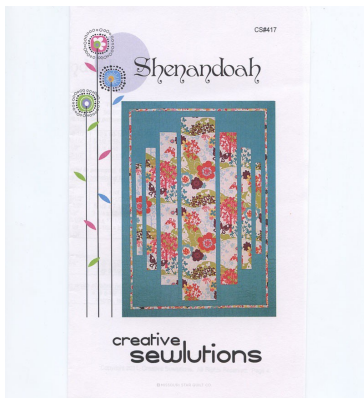

Fabric Gluing Investigation Station

- Let's check out the products available for gluing your fabrics for applique or other techniques.

Class Supply Lists

Puff Pastry

25 charm squares or 5" squares

Fat quarter or ¼ yard muslin

1/3 yard light fabric for setting triangles

5/8 yard medium or coordinating fabric for borders

¼ yard fabric for binding

1 yard backing fabric

34" square batting

Water-soluble marking pen

Shenandoah

Fabric requirements vary by quilt size, see pattern

Large or scenic prints work well

I'm Outta Here!

Blue: 1/3 yard

White: 1/3 yard

Black: 1/4 yard

Backing: 22" square

Batting: 21" square of a very thin but substantial batting, such as Hobbs Thermore

One pair doll shoes size 6 or 8 (I ordered mine from dollsupply.com)

One pair doll socks to fit an 11" to 15" doll

Fabric Glue

Mystery Quilt!

See instruction pages 1 and 2.

Community Sewing blocks

One white and one batik fat quarter per block

Kids Kamp

13-20 6 ½ inch strips (color, color, color!)

1 yard fabric for border (if time permits)

Sewing machine with ¼ inch foot

Rotary cutter with a new blade

Neutral thread and 2 filled bobbins

Cutting mat and two 6 inch rulers

Needles, size 80, sharp or Microtex

Thread snips or scissors

Fabric Requirements

A "worm" is a strip of fabric 2½" x approximately 42" with selvages on each of the short ends.

Worms

thirty (eighteen)

If some of your strips are not at least 41" long, have some scraps or a few additional "worms" available to cut pieces when you run short.

Background (must contrast with all the worms)

1¾ (1⅛) yards

Sashing

⅞ (⅞) yard

Border

1⅝ (1¼) yards

Backing

4 (3⅞) yards

Binding

¾ (¾) yard

Other Supplies

Sewing machine

Thread to blend with fabrics

Rotary cutter, mat, and basic rulers

Cutting

Strips are cut across the width of the fabric making them approximately 40" long with selvages on each of the short ends.

The sizes of the pieces are the same whether you are making the larger quilt or the smaller quilt. The numbers of pieces differ: more pieces for the larger quilt, fewer for the smaller quilt.

Background

Cut twenty (twelve) strips 2½" wide.

Use these strips to cut 320 (192) 2½" squares.

There is more cutting of background fabric in the final step.

The worms will be cut during the construction of the quilt.
